- Bill Parfet's private collection of high end cars and wooden boats. Some of his cars are usually on display at the GCM, like his Auburn collection (one of every body in the V12 Solon series, all painted the same). Also, his Mercedes 540K. He is one of the grand children of Donald Gilmore who started the GCM. His property abuts the GCM.
- The Off Brothers private collection of high end and eclectic vehicles. Bill Johnston and Ron Ellenbos. Bill is married to Rhonda Stryker (granddaughter of Homer Stryker who started Stryker Medical). Ron was an executive in the company.
- Chief Noonday Car Park. Terry Cole is a REO Club member, owning a few. He also, has a number of Cole cars. He has a restoration campus and facility for patrons to store their cars and then occasionally fly/ drive in to take them to shows. It's situated on an old golf driving range.
- Mike Howard. Has a private collection of about 25 pre 1920's cars, mostly brass. They are housed in a warehouse in the city. He has a REO and one or two Mighty Michigan cars that were built in Kalamazoo in 1912/13.
